Day 1 NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport – Darjeeling (75 kms / 3 hrs)

Your journey begins the moment you arrive at NJP Railway Station or IXB Airport, where our warm and welcoming guide will greet you with a smile. From here, embark on a scenic drive of 75 kilometers to Darjeeling, perched at an altitude of 6,950 feet, where the cool mountain breeze and breathtaking landscapes will greet you along the way. As you drive through lush valleys and charming hills, the anticipation of exploring this enchanting hill station builds with every turn. Upon arrival in Darjeeling, check into your hotel and take some time to relax, soaking in the serene atmosphere of this picturesque town. Whether you choose to unwind in the comfort of your hotel or step out for a leisurely stroll, the rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your own pace. With the majestic mountains and vibrant culture awaiting you, your stay in Darjeeling promises to be a memorable one. Enjoy an overnight stay in this tranquil haven, where the beauty of nature and the warmth of the local hospitality combine to make you feel right at home.

Day 2 Darjeeling Sightseeing

Your day begins early at 4:00 AM with a visit to the iconic Tiger Hill, where you'll be treated to a spectacular sunrise over the Himalayan range. On a clear morning, witness the golden hues of the sun gradually illuminating the snow-capped peaks of Kanchenjunga, the world's third-highest mountain, as the landscape comes to life in front of your eyes. Not far from here, challenge yourself at Tenzing Rock, a 50-foot-high rock face named after the legendary Tenzing Norgay, offering a unique climbing experience. Feel the cool mountain breeze as you take a ride on the Ropeway, offering sweeping views of Darjeeling and its lush tea gardens. A visit to the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed on Sundays) will provide insight into Tibetan culture and craftsmanship, while the Tea Gardens (outer view) present a postcard-perfect scene of rolling green hills and tea pickers at work. Next, experience tranquility at the Japanese Temple, where serenity and spirituality meet, and take a step back in time with a visit to the Ghoom Monastery, home to the 15-foot Maitreya Buddha statue. Finally, marvel at the Batasia Loop, an engineering wonder where the famous Darjeeling Himalayan Railway weaves a spiral track through stunning gardens, offering an incredible view of the surrounding mountains. As the day comes to a close, enjoy some free time in the evening to shop for local souvenirs or simply relax, soaking in the charm of Darjeeling. After a day filled with adventure, culture, and history, return to your hotel for a peaceful overnight stay.

Day 3 Darjeeling – Gangtok (100 kms / 4 hrs)

Day 4 Excursion to Tsomgo Lake & Baba Mandir

Take in the serene atmosphere, and if you're lucky, you may spot vibrant prayer flags fluttering in the breeze, adding a touch of spirituality to the landscape. A little higher at 13,200 feet lies the Baba Mandir, a shrine dedicated to Baba Harbhajan Singh, a revered Indian Army soldier. The site, steeped in legend and patriotism, exudes a profound sense of peace and respect. Many visit the mandir not just for its spiritual significance but also to pay homage to a soldier whose legacy continues to inspire. After immersing yourself in the natural beauty and cultural richness of these high-altitude wonders, return to Gangtok. Relax and enjoy your evening at leisure, reflecting on the day's experiences. End your day with a comfortable overnight stay, cherishing the memories of these

enchanting sights. (Note: In case of landslides or any other reasons that restrict access to Tsomgo Lake, alternate sightseeing options will be provided.)

Day 5 Gangtok Local Sightseeing

Next, explore the Cottage Industry and Handicraft Centre (closed on Sundays and the 1st & 3rd Saturday of each month), a treasure trove of traditional crafts where you can witness artisans at work and shop for unique souvenirs. Dive deeper into the region's cultural heritage at the Institute of Tibetology (closed on Sundays). This renowned center for Tibetan studies houses an impressive collection of artifacts, scriptures, and Buddhist relics, offering a glimpse into the spiritual and academic richness of Tibetan Buddhism. Nearby, visit the Dro-dul Chorten, a sacred stupa surrounded by prayer wheels that hum with a meditative rhythm. Your journey continues to Gonjang Monastery, a serene sanctuary that radiates peace and spirituality. Finally, wrap up your day with a visit to the enchanting Banjakhri Falls, a picturesque waterfall nestled amidst lush greenery, where you can relax and enjoy the soothing sounds of nature. After a day filled with exploration and discovery, return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay in Gangtok, cherishing the vibrant experiences of this captivating hill town.

Day 6 Gangtok – NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport (120 kms / 5 hrs)
