Nearby, Patan Durbar Square and the Golden Temple showcase the architectural splendor of the Kathmandu Valley, while Boudhanath Stupa invites you to immerse yourself in Tibetan culture and religious practices. The Pashupatinath Temple, one of the most revered Hindu temples in Nepal, holds a special place in the hearts of devotees, and witnessing the Pashupati Bagmati Aarati is a spiritual experience that will stay with you forever.
 For those seeking a break from the bustle of city life, a day trip to Chandragiri Hills offers breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains, from the Annapurna range to Everest. A cable car ride takes you to the summit, where you can visit the Bhaleshwor Temple and enjoy uninterrupted vistas of the Himalayas.
 Kathmandu is not just a place; it's an experience that will captivate your senses and leave you yearning to return. Whether you're drawn to its sacred temples, its bustling markets, or the tranquil beauty of the surrounding mountains, this city has something to offer every traveler.

Day 1 ARRIVE IN KATHMANDU

Upon your arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our representative will greet you and transfer you to your hotel. After completing the check-in process, you will receive a brief overview of the tour itinerary. Enjoy an overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 2 FULL DAY KATHMANDU SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, your day of cultural discovery begins! First, visit Swayambhunath Temple (Monkey Temple), a sacred Buddhist site atop a hill, offering panoramic views of the valley. Dating back more than 2,000 years, it is one of Nepal's oldest stupas. Next, explore Patan Durbar Square, a historic Buddhist city filled with temples and courtyards, and the Golden Temple, a revered Buddhist monastery. In the afternoon, visit Boudhanath Stupa, the largest Buddhist stupa in the world, a hub for Tibetan culture and religious activities. Your day concludes with a visit to the Pashupatinath Temple, one of the holiest Hindu temples, where you can witness the awe-inspiring Pashupati Bagmati Aarati ceremony. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3 DAY TRIP TO CHANDRAGIRI

After breakfast, take a scenic drive to Chandragiri Hills, located about an hour from Kathmandu. From the top, enjoy sweeping views of the entire Kathmandu Valley and, on clear days, the majestic Himalayas, from Annapurna to Everest. Take the cable car up to the summit and visit the Bhaleshwor Temple. After taking in the stunning vistas, return to Kathmandu by cable car and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

DEPARTURE TRANSFER

After breakfast, our representative will transfer you to the airport for your flight, ensuring you have plenty of time before your departure. The breathtaking land of Nepal has many more secrets waiting to be discovered—come back for more adventures in the Himalayas!

This means that the vehicle will be available for the specified activities and transfers mentioned in the package, but not for additional or unscheduled trips.
- Itinerary is subject to change without any prior notice.
- No rooms on Hold. Confirmation will be subject to availability at the time of confirmation.
- Tour itinerary may be shuffled due to the inclement weather conditions and changes in Flight/ Ferry operations, which may incur extra charges.
- All the passengers should carry the valid ID during the travel
- Peak Season / Weekend Surcharges may be applicable at the time of confirmation. This will be intimated at the time of booking. However we will not be able to get this information prior.
- Child below 2 years is considered as infant and 2 years to 11 years are considered to be child.
- All the services included in the package are compulsory and no refund will be given if any of the services are not taken.
- Flights arriving Early Morning or Late Evening & departing Early Morning or Late Evening, passengers needs to book Private Transfers if Schedule Transfer is not operational
