 In addition to the temples, Kathmandu's bustling Durbar Square and the Thamel district provide a fascinating mix of history, culture, and local life. The nearby Patan Durbar Square, with its beautiful temples and the Golden Temple, offers a deeper look into the city's blend of Hinduism and Buddhism, making it a must-see for history and architecture lovers. Kathmandu is a city that invites you to wander, explore, and be inspired by its diverse offerings.
 A short drive from Kathmandu lies Nagarkot, a peaceful hill station famous for its sweeping views of the Himalayas, including Mount Everest on clear days. En route, a stop at Bhaktapur adds a cultural layer to your journey. Bhaktapur, known as the "City of Temples," is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with a collection of ancient shrines, courtyards, and spectacular examples of Nepali architecture. The Golden Gate and the 55-Window Temple are among the treasures that define Bhaktapur's rich cultural history.
 Nagarkot itself offers a serene retreat, where the sunrise and sunset views over the Kathmandu Valley and the surrounding peaks create a magical atmosphere. The town is also home to a variety of butterfly species, adding to its charm as a peaceful getaway. Whether you're relaxing in the hills or exploring the bustling city of Kathmandu, this journey offers the perfect balance of spirituality, culture, and natural beauty.

Day 1 ARRIVE IN KATHMANDU

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our representative will greet you and transfer you to your hotel. After check-in, you will receive a briefing on the itinerary. Spend your first night in Kathmandu.

Day 2 FULL DAY KATHMANDU SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, your cultural exploration of Kathmandu begins. Start with a visit to the Pashupatinath Temple, one of the holiest sites for Hindus, where you'll witness powerful rituals and ceremonies. Next, head to Swayambhunath Temple (Monkey Temple), perched on a hill just outside the city, offering panoramic views of the valley. This ancient stupa, dating back over 2,000 years, is the oldest of its kind in Nepal and is surrounded by shrines and monasteries. In the afternoon, visit Boudhanath Stupa, the largest Buddhist stupa in the world. This landmark is not only an important religious site but also a place where you can experience Tibetan culture, with its markets offering everything from jewelry to hand-woven carpets. Finally, visit Patan Durbar Square and the Golden Temple, where you can explore centuries-old temples and vibrant courtyards in the heart of Patan, one of Nepal's oldest Buddhist cities. Return to Kathmandu for an overnight stay.

Day 3 DRIVE TO NAGARKOT, ENROUTE BHAKTAPUR

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and head to Nagarkot, a hill station famous for its breathtaking sunrise and sunset views. On your way, visit Bhaktapur, known as the "city of worshippers" or "city of temples." The Bhaktapur Durbar Square is home to ancient temples, shrines, and statues that showcase Nepalese craftsmanship. You can also admire highlights like the Golden Gate and the 55-Window Temple. Continue your journey to Nagarkot, which offers sweeping views of the Kathmandu Valley and a panoramic view of the Himalayas. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Nagarkot.

Day 4 DEPARTURE TRANSFER

If weather permits, wake up early to witness the stunning sunrise over the Himalayas from the hotel. After breakfast, our representative will transfer you to the airport in time for your flight departure, bringing an end to your unforgettable journey through Nepal.
