Kathmandu & Pokhara

Kathmandu and Pokhara offer a dynamic blend of cultural heritage and natural beauty, making them two of Nepal's most iconic destinations. Kathmandu, the capital, is a cultural heartland filled with sacred temples, ancient shrines, and vibrant markets. Visitors can explore the iconic Pashupatinath Temple, where spiritual rituals unfold along the banks of the Bagmati River, and the Swayambhunath Stupa (Monkey Temple), one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal. The vast Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest of its kind in the world, offers a glimpse into Tibetan culture, with lively monasteries and markets surrounding it. Patan Durbar Square adds to the cultural wealth of the valley, showcasing the finest examples of Nepali architecture and art.
 A road trip to Pokhara follows, where the natural beauty of Nepal unfolds in breathtaking fashion. Known as the "Tourist Capital of Nepal," Pokhara sits at the base of the majestic Annapurna range and is renowned for its serene lakes, tranquil atmosphere, and adventure-filled activities. A visit to the Bindhabasini Temple, dedicated to the goddess Durga, gives a spiritual touch to the journey, while Davis Falls and the mysterious Mahadev Cave captivate with their natural wonders. The World Peace Pagoda offers stunning panoramic views of the town, the surrounding mountains, and Phewa Lake below. A boat ride on the calm waters of Phewa Lake is the perfect way to end the day, with the mountains reflecting in the water providing a postcard-perfect scene.

ARRIVE IN KATHMANDU

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our representative will greet you and transfer you to your hotel. After completing the check-in, you'll receive a briefing on the tour itinerary. Enjoy your first overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 2 FULL DAY KATHMANDU SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, your cultural exploration begins with a visit to the Pashupatinath Temple, one of the holiest sites for Hindus, where rituals take place along the Bagmati River. Next, head to Swayambhunath Temple (Monkey Temple), perched on a hill just 3 km from Kathmandu. This 2,000-year-old stupa is one of the oldest in Nepal. In the afternoon, visit the Boudhanath Stupa, the world's largest Buddhist stupa, which is an excellent place to observe Tibetan culture. Finally, explore Patan Durbar Square and the Golden Temple, a historical Buddhist monastery in Patan, one of Nepal's oldest Buddhist cities. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 3

DRIVE TO POKHARA

After breakfast, begin your scenic road trip to Pokhara (approximately 7 hours). Known as the "Tourist Capital of Nepal," Pokhara is a popular base for treks and offers stunning views of the Annapurna range. The Lakeside area is a popular spot for boating, surrounded by cozy cafés, shops, and restaurants. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and enjoy an evening stroll by the lakeside or relax in this peaceful town. Overnight in Pokhara.

HALF DAY POKHARA SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, visit Bindhabasini Temple, dedicated to goddess Durga, and admire its 16th-century architecture. Next, explore Davis Falls (Patale Changgo), an underground waterfall that flows through a 500-foot tunnel. Visit Mahadev Cave (Gupteshwor Cave), dedicated to Lord Shiva, and admire the Seti Gorge, a river that runs underground in parts. Continue your tour with a visit to the World Peace Pagoda on Anadu Hill, offering panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and Pokhara. Conclude your sightseeing with a peaceful boat ride on Fewa Lake. Overnight in Pokhara.

Day 5 DRIVE BACK TO KATHMANDU

After breakfast, embark on a drive back to Kathmandu. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 6 DEPARTURE

After breakfast, enjoy some free time until departure. Our representative will ensure you're transferred to the airport 3 hours before your flight time for your onward journey. The land of the Himalayas has many more wonders to uncover—come back again for more adventures!
