The Doleshwor Mahadev Temple, nestled in serene surroundings, holds significant religious value as it is believed to be the head of the Kedarnath Temple, offering a peaceful retreat for spiritual seekers.

Next, visit Doleshwor Mahadev Temple, a significant religious site for Hindus. This temple is believed to be the head of the bull form of Lord Shiva, linked to the famous Kedarnath Temple in India. Surrounded by peaceful landscapes, this temple offers a spiritually enriching experience. After a day of sightseeing, return to your hotel for a relaxing evening and overnight stay.
