Finally, we'll visit Swayambhunath Stupa, also known as the "Monkey Temple," famous for its resident monkey population. After a fulfilling day, we'll return to the hotel in Kathmandu for an overnight stay.

Day 3

Bhaktapur & Doleshwor Mahadev Temple Visit.

After Breakfast we will proceed for the sightseeing of Bhaktapur Durbar Square, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its wellpreserved medieval architecture. It showcases traditional palaces, courtyards, temples, and intricate wood carvings, reflecting the rich cultural heritage of the Newari people. Later we will move towards Doleshwor Mahadev Temple Which holds great religious importance for Hindus. It is believed to be a part of the famous Kedarnath Temple in India and is considered the head part of the bull form taken by Lord Shiva. The temple's serene surroundings offer a spiritually uplifting experience. After a day of sightseeing at Bhaktapur Durbar Square and Doleshwor Mahadev Temple, we will return to the hotel for a relaxing evening. You can enjoy the comforts of the hotel and have a peaceful overnight stay.

Day 4

Depart Kathmandu
