Mystical Nepal Tour Dom-054

Nepal Twin Valley with Muktinath Tour as the name suggests it covers two most popular valley tour of the country, Kathmandu and Pokhara. This tour is a fine blend of religion, culture and nature. Kathmandu- the city of temples covers core religious and historically important UNESCO World Heritage sites; where travelers can understand culture and lifestyle of Nepalese people. This tour also covers Pokhara - known as Switzerland of Asia which gives magnificent view of western Himalayan ranges including Mt Fishtail, Annapurna, Dhaulagiri and other mountain peaks, lakes, waterfall, etc. Also Muktinath is a Vishnu temple, sacred to both Hindus and Buddhists. It is located in Muktinath Valley at the foot of the Thorong La mountain pass in Mustang, Nepal. It is one of the world's highest temples. Within Hinduism, it is one of the 108 Divya Desams, and is the only Divya Desam located outside India. Beside the popular Pilgrimage, nature and cultural site tour, during this tour one can be involved in various adventure activity, night life, casinos, discotheques, shopping, etc.

Arrival in Tribhuvan International airport

Once you arrive at the Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, look out for our representative who will be holding a placard with your name on it. A short drive and you will be in your hotel, our tour officer will help you complete all the check-in procedure and brief you about tour itinerary. In the evening you can head over to Thamel, the main tourist hub where you can have some good time at the bar or a club on own. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 2 Kathmandu City Tour

Today you get to kick-start your cultural discovery! We have a lot of sightseeing in store for you starting with Kathmandu, the nerve-center of Nepal. It flaunts its rich history and vibrant culture in every possible nook and cranny. Visit Pashupatinath Temple. According to religious belief Lord Pashupatinath is the almighty God and savior of all human beings. It is therefore said that all Hindu should pay homage to Lord Pashupatinath at least once in their lifetime for their eternal peace and salvation. Then after make your way to the largest stupa in the world Boudhanath Stupa built in the fifth century. Before the present day Stupa was build, it was an overnight camp of Tibetan businessman. Today it is best site to observe Tibetan lifestyle, culture and religious practices of monks. It is also popular for Tibetan Jewelry, hand-woven carpets, thanka, masks, khukuri, knives, and more Tibetan products. Continue towards, Patan Durbar Square- the center of Fine art. Patan Durbar Square and as you walk past the whitewashed gate, you enter a square lined with cafes, grocery stores and huge iron bells. Still beyond the alleys lie mostly medieval neighborhoods of the city. Temples and Stupas are in abundance, in various shapes, sizes and antiquity. Continuing visit towards Swoyambhunath Stupa meaning the "the selfexistent" is popular among foreigners owing to the large monkey population residing in the area. No wonder why it's also called "Monkey Temple". Make sure you keep an eye out for these notorious creatures. Return back to hotel. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 3 Drive to Pokhara

Following breakfast, our adventure begins with a scenic drive to Pokhara(210km, 7-8 hrs drive) offering views of rivers, terrace fields and captivating view of the Annapurna range as you near the city- scenic lake city. (En-route visit to Manakamana Devi Temple by cable car). Feel free to take a stroll through the city in the evening or relax by the lakeside. Overnight in Pokhara.

Day 4 Fly to Jomsom & Drive Muktinath

Early morning transfer to airport for flight to Jomsom. Arrive Jomsom after 25 minutes scenic flight and walk to hotel/ Resort. After get refreshed walk to the local Jeep stand for further journey to Muktinath. Arrive at the base of the Muktidham temple and climb approximately 300 steps to main temple. Take holy bath at 108 holy water spouts, visit and pray Jwalamai temple and other temples. Return to Jeep stand for return journey to Jomsom. Arrive Jomsom and check into hotel. Overnight in Jomsom.

Day 5

Fly back to Pokhara & sightseeing tour

Wake up earlyand walk to airport for flight back to Pokhara. Upon arrival in Pokhara, transfer to hotel and check-in. Get freshen up and rest for a while. Then, Proceed for visit to Bindabasini Temple dedicated to goddess Durga- the deity of supreme power, right in the center of the bazaar. The 16th century architecture is sure to delight you. Davis falls, or "Patale Changgo" in Nepali is actually an underground waterfall. The water flows under the ground through its natural tunnel of 500 feet from the fall made by the water currents beneath the land. Move towards Mahadev Cave, also known as Gupteshwor Cave is limestone cave with its shrine desiccated to Lord Shiva. The cave is said to have been discovered in 16th Century. Watch the Seti Gorge standing atop the Mahendra Pul. Flowing right through the city, the river runs completely underground at places. There's lot more to do in Pokhara, just stride down to the lakeside area in the evening. Overnight in Pokhara.

After breakfast drive back Kathmandu. Upon arriving, transfer to your respective hotel. Rest of the time free at leisure on your own. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 7 Depart Kathmandu

Our cheerful representative will drop you off to the airport three hours prior to the flight departure. The mystic land of the Himalayas holds many more secrets to be told. Come back again for another adventure visiting our spectacular mountains.
