# Day 1 Arrive at Dehradun – Transfer to Mussoorie

Arrive at Dehradun and enjoy a scenic drive to Mussoorie, often called the "Queen of the Hills." Upon arrival in the late afternoon, check into your hotel and relax. The evening is free to explore the town at your leisure, soaking in the cool atmosphere. Enjoy a restful night at your hotel.

# Day 2 Mussoorie Local Sightseeing Tour

After a hearty breakfast, set off for a day of exploration. Begin with a visit to the famous Kempty Falls, a picturesque cascade located 15 km from Mussoorie. Continue your sightseeing with a trip to Cloud Ends, the highest point in Mussoorie, which offers a panoramic view of the valley. Then, take a stroll along Camel's Back Road, where the rocks resemble the hump of a camel. Visit Gun Hill Point, the second-highest point in the area, offering stunning views, accessible via a cable car ride. Finally, head to Lal Tibba (Red Hills), located 6 km from the town, a popular spot to catch the mesmerizing sunset or sunrise. End the day with a leisurely walk on the Mall Road. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

## Day 3 Mussoorie – Day Trip to Dhanaulti

After breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to Dhanaulti, located 33 km from Mussoorie. Visit the ancient mountain-top shrine of Surkhanda Devi, perched at 9,700 feet, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding snow-capped peaks and lush valleys. Explore the beautiful Eco Park, surrounded by deodar and pine trees. After a day immersed in nature, return to Mussoorie and enjoy a peaceful evening. Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 4** Mussoorie to Dehradun – Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Dehradun for your onward journey, concluding your charming hill station escape.
