Mussoorie Nainital - Uttarakhand

Mussoorie, often referred to as the "Queen of the Hills," is a picturesque hill station that sits gracefully on the foothills of the Himalayas. Known for its cool climate, scenic beauty, and colonial charm, Mussoorie remains a favorite among nature lovers and history enthusiasts alike. The town is encircled by lush green forests, offering breathtaking views of the Doon Valley and the Shivalik hills. Visitors can enjoy the serenity of Gun Hill, the highest point in Mussoorie, or explore the Kempty Waterfalls, which are a major attraction for tourists. Apart from the safari, the park offers scenic views, and the nearby Corbett Wildlife Museum adds a touch of educational value to the visit.
 Further south, Nainital provides another peaceful retreat, known for its beautiful Naini Lake, surrounded by hills and forests. The town has been a favorite for tourists for years, offering a mix of adventure, tranquility, and spirituality. Visitors can enjoy boating on the lake, visit the Naina Devi Temple, or take a leisurely walk along the famous Mall Road. The Snow View Point offers panoramic views of the snow-covered peaks, and Eco Cave Gardens is perfect for those looking to connect with nature. With its calm environment and rich cultural heritage, Nainital complements Mussoorie and Jim Corbett perfectly, offering a complete experience for travelers.

Day 1

Upon arrival at Dehradun Airport, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to Mussoorie, the "Queen of the Hills." Check into your hotel and relax. Overnight stay in Mussoorie.

Day 2 Mussoorie Sightseeing

After breakfast, embark on a day of exploration in Mussoorie. Visit the famous Kempty Falls, a popular tourist spot, followed by a visit to Company Garden, a well-maintained garden with a variety of flowers. Then, head to Gun Hill Point, one of the highest points in the area, offering spectacular views of the valley. The evening is free for shopping at Mall Road, a charming stretch known for its quaint shops and local products. Overnight stay at your hotel in Mussoorie.

Day 3 Mussoorie to Jim Corbett

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and drive to Jim Corbett National Park, a haven for wildlife enthusiasts. On arrival, check into your hotel and relax for the night. Overnight stay in Jim Corbett.

Jim Corbett Sightseeing – Transfer to Nainital

Start your day with breakfast, and enjoy an exciting jungle safari at Jim Corbett National Park (at your own cost), where you may spot a variety of wildlife, including tigers, elephants, and various bird species. Visit the Corbett Wildlife Museum to learn about the park's diverse flora and fauna. Take a moment to enjoy the breathtaking views at Dhikala. In the evening, proceed to Nainital, a serene lake town, and check into your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 5 Nainital Sightseeing

After breakfast, explore the beautiful hill station of Nainital. Start your day with a boat ride on the famous Naini Lake (at your own cost), followed by a visit to the Naina Devi Temple. Visit Eco Cave for an adventurous experience and Snow View Point for panoramic views of the snow-capped peaks. In the evening, indulge in some shopping at Mall Road, which offers a variety of souvenirs and local handicrafts. Overnight stay in Nainital.

Day 6 Nainital to Dehradun

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Dehradun for your onward journey. You will be dropped off at the Dehradun Airport or Railway Station for your departure.
