You'll also visit the Topkapi Palace, the former administrative heart of the Ottoman Empire, with its breathtaking courtyards and rich history. Later, head to the bustling Taksim Square, the vibrant centre of modern Istanbul. Explore the area, dine at local restaurants, or take a ride on the iconic old tram to the Galata Tower, which offers stunning views of the city.

Day 3

Boat Trip on the Bosphorus – Sailing Between Two Continents

Today, embark on a Bosphorus boat trip, cruising along this strait that connects the Black Sea with the Sea of Marmara, dividing Istanbul into Europe and Asia. The 2-hour journey will offer incredible views of Ottoman palaces, ancient wooden houses, and luxurious villas. Sail beneath the bridges that link two continents and experience the charm of the lively strait with its myriad of boats. Enjoy the serenity and beauty of Istanbul from the water before some free time to explore at your leisure.

Ephesus – Ancient Marvels and Coastal Beauty

After breakfast, we depart early for a scenic journey across Turkey's interior. We'll arrive in Ephesus, one of the best-preserved ancient cities of Asia Minor, where more than 250,000 people once lived. Explore the archaeological wonders of Saint John's Basilica, the house of the Virgin Mary, and the impressive ruins of Ephesus, which include the magnificent Temple of Artemis, the grand Library of Celsus, and the Great Theatre. Afterwards, continue to the coastal town of Kusadasi, known for its lively commercial atmosphere and a small castle. Enjoy a delicious dinner and overnight stay here.

Day 5 Journey Through Anatolia – Discover Modern and Historic **Turkey**

Today, we continue through Anatolia, with a brief visit to Izmir, Turkey's fourth-largest city, known for its modern, westernized lifestyle. Continue on to Bursa, a city with rich Ottoman history and UNESCO-listed sites. Discover the city's traditional bazaars, Green Mosque, and its remarkable religious schools and public baths. In the evening, we'll return to Istanbul. End of our services for the day, and if you need additional accommodation, check with the hotel.
