Day 1

NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport - Darjeeling (75 Kms. / 3 Hrs.)

Your journey begins with a warm welcome at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station or Bagdogra International Airport. From here, embark on a picturesque drive to Darjeeling, perched gracefully at an altitude of 6,950 feet. Day 3

Darjeeling - Kalimpong - Local Sightseeing (77 Kms. / 6½ Hrs.)

Day 5

Excursion to Tsomgo Lake and Baba Mandir (53 Kms. / 3 Hrs. one-way)
