Day 1 NJP RIy Station / IXB Airport - Darjeeling (75 Kms. / 3 Hrs.)

Upon your arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station or Bagdogra International Airport, you'll be greeted with warm smiles and transferred to the

enchanting hill station of Darjeeling, nestled at an altitude of 6,950 feet. Soar through the skies on a thrilling ride at the Ropeway, offering breathtaking views of Darjeeling's scenic landscapes. Continue your journey with a visit to the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed on Sundays), where you'll gain insight into Tibetan culture, followed by a visit to the lush Tea Gardens, offering a glimpse of Darjeeling's famous tea industry (outer view). Conclude your sightseeing with a peaceful visit to the serene Japanese Temple, where the tranquil atmosphere provides a perfect retreat.
