From the tranquil beauty of Tiger Hill to the inspiring Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, the vibrant Himalayan Zoo, and the serene Japanese Temple, Darjeeling is a treasure trove of experiences. Whether you're strolling through the Batashiya Loop or marveling at the cascading Rock Garden, every corner of this hill station promises to captivate your senses and leave you yearning for more.

Day 1 NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport - Darjeeling (75 Kms. / 3 Hrs.)

Your journey begins with a warm welcome upon arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station or Bagdogra International Airport. From here, embark on a picturesque drive to the charming hill town of Darjeeling, perched gracefully at 6,950 feet. As you ascend, let the cool mountain breeze and the serene landscapes of lush tea gardens, quaint villages, and meandering rivers set the tone for your adventure ahead. Upon reaching Darjeeling, check in to your cozy hotel and unwind after your journey. The rest of the day is yours to soak in the tranquil vibes of the hills or explore the surroundings at your leisure. As the evening falls, let the crisp mountain air and twinkling lights of the town prepare you for the enchanting experiences that await. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

Day 2 Darjeeling Full Day Sightseeing with Tiger Hill

Day 3 Darjeeling - Pelling (80 Kms. / 4 Hrs.)

Day 4 Pelling Full Day Sightseeing with Skywalk

Day 6 Excursion to Tsomgo Lake and Baba Mandir (53 Kms. / 3 Hrs. one-way)

As you make your way back to Gangtok, soak in the breathtaking Himalayan landscapes that accompany you throughout the journey. The evening is yours to unwind and explore Gangtok at your leisure. Overnight stay at Gangtok.

Day 7 Gangtok - Lachung (116 Kms. / 6 Hrs.)

After a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel in Gangtok and embark on a picturesque journey to Lachung, perched at an altitude of 8,738 ft. in North Sikkim.
