## Day 1 Arrival in Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC)

Chao Ban! Welcome to the lively city of Ho Chi Minh. Upon your arrival, you will be greeted at the airport and transferred to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure, resting or exploring the city's vibrant streets to form your first impressions of Vietnam. Dinner is at your own pace. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

## Day 2 Cu Chi Tunnels & Ho Chi Minh City Tour

After breakfast, set out at 8:30 AM for a journey into the Cu Chi countryside. Explore the famous Cu Chi Tunnels, a 200-kilometer underground network used during the war. Crawl through a section of the tunnels and gain insight into the resourcefulness of the guerrilla fighters. Also, visit a local rice paper workshop to witness traditional craftsmanship. In the afternoon, discover the soul of Ho Chi Minh City through its bustling streets and historic landmarks. Visit the vibrant Cho Lon market, a hidden Chinese pagoda, and iconic sites like Notre Dame Cathedral, the Central Post Office, and City Hall. Conclude the tour at around 5:30 PM and return to your hotel. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

## Day 3 Mekong Delta Adventure (My Tho)

Leave the bustling streets of Ho Chi Minh City behind as you head to My Tho, a serene town on the banks of the Mekong River. Board a sampan to cruise through the river and explore the famed Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise Islands. Stroll through lush orchards on Unicorn Island, enjoy tropical fruits, and experience traditional folk music performed by locals. Continue with visits to a fruit plantation, a honey-bee farm where you'll savor honey tea, and a coconut candy workshop. Enjoy a peaceful hand-rowed sampan ride along the Thoi Son canal, immersing yourself in the tranquil countryside. After this enriching experience, return to Ho Chi Minh City for an overnight stay.

## Day 4 Departure from Ho Chi Minh City

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Depending on your flight schedule, you may have time for some last-minute shopping or relaxation. Later, transfer to the airport (without a guide) for your departure flight. Goodbye, and we hope to welcome you back to Vietnam soon!
