Day 1

NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport - Namchi (105 Kms. / 4½ Hrs.)

From Tsomgo Lake, continue your journey to the revered Baba Mandir, located at 13,200 feet. The drive to Baba Mandir offers spectacular views of the rugged terrain and adds to the sense of adventure and wonder. Day 7
