The Vivekananda Rock, where Swami Vivekananda meditated, offers a tranquil setting with panoramic ocean views. The Mahatma Gandhi Memorial is another poignant site in this region, commemorating the great leader's visit to Kanyakumari. End your day by witnessing one of the most breathtaking sunsets in India, as the sun dips into the waters, creating a mesmerizing spectacle. This trip offers a perfect blend of history, spirituality, and natural beauty, making it a must-visit for every traveler.

Day 1 Arrival in Trivandrum – Exploring the Capital

Arrive at Trivandrum, the capital city of Kerala, and transfer to the hotel for check-in. Pay a visit to the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial, dedicated to the Father of the Nation. In the evening, witness one of the most spectacular sunsets at Kanyakumari, where the sun sets into the vast expanse of the ocean. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3 Departure from Kanyakumari – Return to Trivandrum

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed back to Trivandrum. You will be dropped at Trivandrum Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey, carrying with you memories of Kerala's rich cultural heritage and the breathtaking beauty of its southernmost shores.
