Day 1

SIEM REAP, SOUR SDEY - "HELLO" CAMBODIA

Arrive at Siem Reap International Airport, where you will go through the immigration process (visa on arrival is available or can be obtained in advance via www.evisa.gov.kh). After collecting your luggage, head to the exit gate where our representative will be waiting to greet you. You'll then be transferred to your hotel in Siem Reap, just a 30-minute drive away, for check-in. With check-in time at 2:00 PM, you'll have some time to freshen up and relax at the hotel. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 2

ANGKOR HIGHLIGHTS

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel, then prepare for a full day of exploring the remarkable Angkor temples. Beat the crowds and head out early at 7:00 AM to Ta Prohm, a temple swallowed by the jungle where enormous tree roots intertwine with the ancient stone blocks in an awe-inspiring embrace. This hauntingly beautiful scene will leave a lasting impression. Next, travel to Angkor Thom, a magnificent fortress constructed by King Jayavarman VII after the Cham occupation in the late 12th century. Begin your exploration at Bayon Temple, renowned for its 54 towers adorned with faces of Avalokiteshvara, symbolizing the king's grandeur and creative genius. Continue to the Terrace of the Leper King and Terrace of Elephants, which served as platforms for the king's public ceremonies. At the southern end of the terrace, visit Baphuon, a stunning temple dating back to the 11th century and known for its intricate carvings and large scale. Finally, make your way to the iconic Angkor Wat, the world's largest religious monument. This temple, a fusion of art, symbolism, and architectural brilliance, is a source of national pride for the Khmer people and a true marvel of ancient engineering. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 3

SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Siem Reap airport for your departure to the next destination. Your unforgettable journey through Cambodia's majestic temples and rich culture concludes here. We thank you for traveling with us and look forward to welcoming you again in the future.
