- For history enthusiasts, the Cu Chi Tunnels provide an opportunity to delve into Vietnam's wartime past, offering a rare chance to experience the underground network that played a crucial role during the war. From the urban excitement of Ho Chi Minh City to the peaceful beauty of the Mekong Delta, South Vietnam is a destination that promises adventure, culture, and history, all wrapped in a vibrant and welcoming atmosphere.

Arrival in Ho Chi Minh City – City Highlights

Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, your guide and vehicle will greet you at the airport for a transfer to the city centre, where your exploration begins. The first stop is the Reunification Palace, once the residence of the President of South Vietnam until the end of the war in 1975. From here, take a short walk to admire some iconic French colonial buildings, including the stunning Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Old Central Post Office. Next, visit Chinatown and the Thien Hau Pagoda, dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea. The intricate friezes, carved tableaux, and impressive incense coils offer excellent photo opportunities. Wander through the narrow streets and head to the Binh Tay Market, where you can witness the vibrant street life and shop for everything from clothes to local dried squid. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

HCM City – Mekong Delta (My Tho) – HCM City

After breakfast, leave the city behind and embark on a journey to My Tho, located on the left bank of the Mekong River. Board a sampan for a scenic cruise around the four beautiful islands—Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise Islands. Stop at Unicorn Island for a leisurely walk through orchards, where you can sample tropical fruits and enjoy traditional folk music performed by local villagers. Visit a fruit plantation to discover the region's agricultural heritage. Lunch is on your own, and afterward, experience the countryside by riding a hand-rowed sampan through the peaceful Thoi Son Canal. Visit a local family-run business, a honey-bee farm, and a coconut candy workshop to learn more about local products. Return to Ho Chi Minh City in the afternoon for an overnight stay.

Day 3 Cu Chi Tunnels – Departure

Begin your morning with a visit to the Cu Chi Tunnels, departing at 8:00 AM from your hotel. Explore the remarkable underground tunnels where Vietnamese guerrilla fighters lived and fought during the war. Crawl through 50-100 meters of the extensive tunnel network and witness firsthand the conditions these fighters endured. Along the way, you'll also stop to see local rice paper workshops and scenic rice paddy fields. Afterward, return to Ho Chi Minh City for some last-minute shopping or relaxation, before transferring to the airport for your departure flight. Farewell, and we hope to welcome you back soon!
