Continue to NisargaDhama, a tranquil island haven surrounded by lush greenery. Upon reaching Coorg, check in at your hotel and unwind. As evening sets in, visit Raja's Seat and soak in panoramic views of the valley, perfect for a memorable sunset. After a day of exploration, return to the hotel for a restful overnight stay in Coorg.

# Day 2 AT COORG
