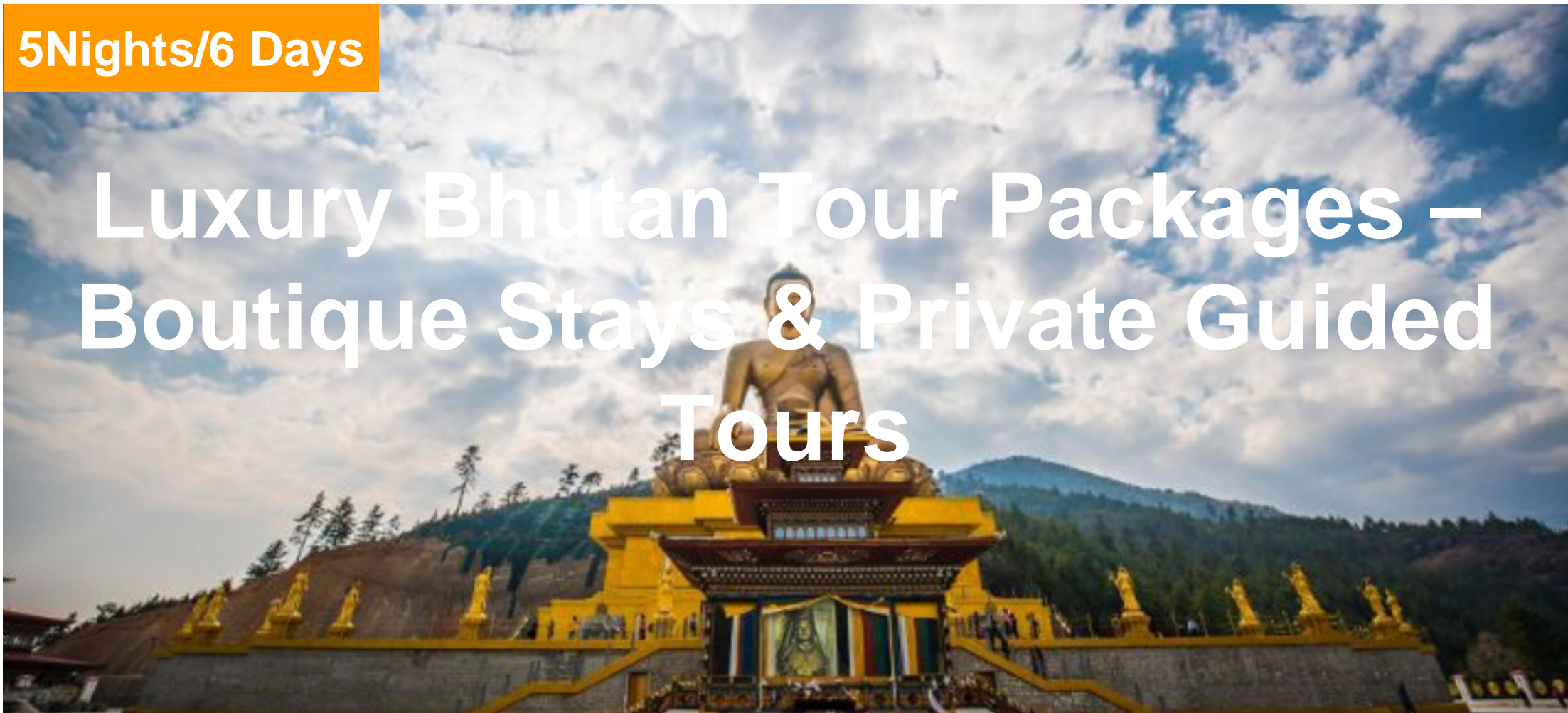

Tourism in Bhutan is centered around exploring its sacred monasteries, majestic dzongs (fortresses), and stunning natural landscapes. Key destinations like Thimphu, the country's capital, blend modern developments with Bhutanese tradition. Here, visitors can explore notable landmarks such as the Memorial Chorten and Tashichho Dzong, as well as the world's largest sitting Buddha statue at Kuensel Phodrang. Punakha, once the capital of Bhutan, is home to the striking Punakha Dzong, located at the confluence of two rivers, and is a popular spot for travelers seeking both spiritual and cultural experiences.
 For nature and adventure lovers, Bhutan offers breathtaking hikes, including the famous trek to the Tiger's Nest Monastery (Taktsang Lhakhang), which clings to a cliffside 900 meters above the Paro Valley. The country's peaceful villages and their connection to traditional lifestyles also provide unique glimpses into rural Bhutanese life. Religious landmarks like the Kyichu Lhakhang, one of Bhutan's oldest temples, and the Rinpung Dzong, an iconic fortress in Paro, showcase the country's deep connection to Buddhism.
 Overall, Bhutan offers a serene and culturally rich experience for those interested in history, spirituality, and the untouched beauty of the Himalayas. Whether exploring the dzongs, hiking through pine forests, or visiting local villages, Bhutan's charm lies in its authenticity and its preservation of ancient traditions amidst the modern world.

Day 1

Arrival at Paro Airport – Thimphu

Arrive at Paro Airport and complete your visa/permit formalities. You will be received by our Bhutan representative and transferred to Thimphu (2320m / 7656ft, 65 km / 1.5-2 hours drive). Thimphu, the capital of Bhutan, is known for its blend of modern development and ancient traditions. Later, visit the Memorial Chorten and Tashichho Dzong. The evening is free for leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2

Thimphu

After breakfast, embark on a sightseeing tour of Thimphu. Visit Kuensel Phodrang (Buddha Point), home to the world's largest sitting Buddha statue at 167 feet. From here, enjoy panoramic views of the Thimphu Valley. Next, visit Motithang Takin Preserve, a small natural reserve for Bhutan's national animal, the Takin. Continue to Changangkha Lhakhang, a 12th-century temple, and then explore Semtokha Dzong, Bhutan's first dzong, now housing a language institute. Overnight in Thimphu.

Day 3

Thimphu – Punakha (75 km / 3 hours drive)

After breakfast, drive to Punakha via the Dochula Pass (3080m), known for its spectacular views of the eastern Himalayas. After checking in at the hotel, visit Punakha Dzong, a massive structure located at the confluence of two rivers. It was Bhutan's capital until 1955 and remains the winter residence of the monk body. In the afternoon, take an excursion to Chimi Lhakhang, the temple of fertility, located in a tranquil setting amidst rice fields. Walk through the village of Pana and observe local life. Evening free to explore Punakha village, situated along the riverbank. Overnight at the hotel in Punakha.

Day 4

Punakha – Paro

After breakfast, drive to Paro. En route, visit Rinpung Dzong, one of Bhutan's most iconic structures, known for its grand architecture and scenic location. Later, visit Ta Dzong (National Museum), which houses a vast collection of Bhutanese art and artefacts. Continue to Kyichu Lhakhang, one of Bhutan's oldest temples, built in the 7th century by Tibetan King Songtsen Gampo. The temple is home to several important relics, including a 7th-century statue of Jowo Sakyamuni. In the evening, visit the Namgay Beer Factory for a glimpse of local brewing traditions. Overnight at the hotel in Paro.

Day 5

Paro – Full Day Hike to Taktsang Lhakhang (Tiger's Nest)

Start early for a full-day hike to Taktsang Lhakhang (Tiger's Nest Monastery), perched on a cliff 900 meters above the Paro valley. The hike takes approximately 2-3 hours one way through pine forests. After reaching the monastery, enjoy its breathtaking views and spiritual significance. In the afternoon, return to Paro and have leisure time to explore the market or relax at the hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Paro.

Day 6

Paro – Onward Connection

After breakfast, transfer to Paro Airport for your onward flight connections. We hope you've enjoyed your journey and look forward to helping you with your future travel plans.
