## Overview Vietnam-cambodia Int-105

## Day 1 ARRIVAL HO CHI MINH CITY VIETNAM – CITY HIGHLIGHTS

Welcome to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam! Our Guide and car will meet you at the airport then transfer to city center and start the tour to explore HCM city. The first place to visit in the tour will be the Reunification Palace, which was the former residence of the President of South Vietnam until end of the war in April 1975. After Reunification Palace, you can walk to see some French colonial structures including Notre Dame Cathedral, the Old Central Post Office. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh. Note: Hotel check in time 14:00

## Day 2 HCM CITY – MEKONG (MY THO) – HCM CITY

After breakfast at hotel, we are leaving the hustle and bustle of Ho Chi Minh City and start your trip to depart for My Tho, the town lies on the left side of the Mekong River. Boarding the sampan and cruising down the river around the four beautiful islands known as Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix and Tortoise islands. Stop over at Unicorn Island, go walking around country lane and seeing orchards, enjoy tropical fruits, folk song music which performed by the local people. Visit the fruit plantation. Lunch on your own expense (No Indian restaurant in Mekong Delta area). Riding a hand-rowed sampan through Thoi Son canal and treat yourself in the beauty of the countryside, visit the family business, visit honey-bee farm, enjoy honey tea and coconut candy workshop. Back to Hochiminh city in the afternoon. Overnight in Hochiminh city.

## Day 3 HO CHI MINH DEPARTURE - SIEM REAP, SOUR SDEY “HELLO” CAMBODIA

Starting at 8:00 AM from your hotel we start with a morning excursion to Cu Chi! Take the opportunity to get in and witness the unique experience of living and fighting underground during the war with a crawl through 50 - 100 meters of the expansive tunnel system. Local rice paper workshops and the rice paddy fields are pleasant sights on the way back to HCM City. Prepare yourself then transfer to the airport for a flight to Siem Reap. (Book late evening flight to Siem Reap). Upon arrival at Siem Reap Int's Airport, process immigration procedure (visa on arrival is available or obtain in advance via [www.evisa.gov.kh](http://www.evisa.gov.kh)), then get your luggage and walk straight to the Exit Gate where our representative is waiting. After self-introduced, you'll transfer directly around 30 minutes to the hotel in the city for check in. Time to fresh-up and relax at hotel. Overnight in Siem Reap.

## Day 4 ANGKOR HIGHLIGHTS

Enjoy breakfast at hotel. Beat the crowd early morning by 7 am; visit the picturesque Ta Prohm that had nearly disappeared into the jungle and remains overgrown, an oddly haunting and exotic scene. The magnificent roots of a tree, pushing between the huge stone blocks of the temple in a sort of embrace, evoke feelings that you may remember forever. We drive to Angkor Thom that was the masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the occupation of Angkor by the Chams from 1177 to 1181, the new king decided to build an impregnable fortress at the heart of his empire. We begin to visit Bayon Temple. At the exact center of Angkor Thom, this is an eccentric expression of the creative genius and inflated ego of Cambodia's most celebrated king. We continue to visit Terrace of the Leper King. Along the Terrace of Elephants, originally used as a viewing gallery for the king to preside over parades, performances and traditional sports. At the southern end lies the Baphuon, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Udayavarma 1 in the 11th century. We journey out to the mother of all temples, Angkor Wat. Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Overnight in Siem Reap.

## Day 5 SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

Transfer to Siem Reap airport for departure to next destination. It's time to say goodbye, we thank you for traveling with us and warmly welcome you to come again.
