Vietnam-cambodia Int-106

ARRIVAL HANOI VIETNAM

Our English-speaking guide will meet and welcome you at Noi Bai international airport. Transfer you to your hotel to check in and take a rest. Note: Check in time 14:00 your arrival flight should be landed after 14:00

HANOI FULL DAY CITY TOUR

Depart at 9:00 AM from your hotel. We begin our day by visiting Uncle Ho at the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and residential grounds learning about his great life (from outside). Next stop is the nearby Temple of Literature, the site of Vietnam's first University. In the afternoon, we visit Dong Xuan Market then take a walk around HoanKiem Lake, Ngoc Son Temple and Hanoi's fascinating Old Quarter. This is your chance to be in the midst of typical Hanoian life and Vietnamese culture. Back your hotel and free for dinner and stay overnight in Ha Noi.

Day 3 HANOI – HA LONG, WELCOME ON THE BOAT (SIC)

Departure for Ha Long Bay is around 8:00 AM in a shared van (about 4 hours) from your hotel. Arrive at the port around noon. Welcomed on board. you are taken to your cabin before the trip briefing. You enjoy a fresh and local seafood lunch while cruising to explore the magic Ha Long Bay. Stop for a swim and visit the mysterious cave. Relax at our secluded island-beach. Later you return back to the boat just in time to watch the beautiful sunset from the top deck before enjoying the bay's freshest seafood dinner. Overnight on the cruise.

Day 4 EXPLORE BAI TU LONG BAY – HANOI – DA NANG

Early risers can enjoy the sunrise and the quiet breath-taking beauty of Bay's landscape with towering limestone. You have breakfast at around 8:00 AM before our short rowboat by the locals of the bay. Have brunch on the boat as we slowly cruise back to boat pier. Hit the road back to Ha Noi. Upon arrival Ha Noi center, our driver picks up and transfers to Hanoi airport for flight to Da Nang. On arrival, pick up and transfer to your hotel (20 minutes) for check in and have free time in the evening. Stay overnight in Danang.

Day 5

BA NA HILL – GOLDEN BRIDGE FULL DAY (B)

Have breakfast at your hotel. 8:00AM Transfer to Ba Na hills (35km from Danang center) and get on the Sunworld Cable Car which gains 5 world scores to Ba Na hills station. Stop at By Night station to visit Vong Nguyet hills, Linh Ung Pagoda, The Old Villas of French. Continue moving up by cable car to the Nui Chua Mountain – the top of Ba Na range, visiting Nghinh Phong top, Le Nim Villas, Orchid Garden... Experience hill climbing train (first and unique funicular in Vietnam) and visit the flower garden Le Jardin D'amour and Linh Ung Pagoda. Enjoy a walk across the famous Golden Bridge and admire the panoramic view over the area of mountain and lush trees. Have lunch by your own choices. After lunch, free for joining games in Fantasy Park – the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with a series of interesting games: 4 – 5D film, skiver, the death race, dinosaur park... Around 5pm, return to your hotel. Overnight in Danang.

Day 6 DA NANG – FLY TO HO CHI MINH

Breakfast at your hotel. Depending on your flight time, our driver will pick you up from your hotel and transfer to the Da Nang airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh, meeting our driver and transfer to the hotel for check in. Overnight in HCM. Your flight from Danang to Ho Chi Minh should be landed after 14:00

CU CHI TUNNELS - HO CHI MINH CITY TOUR FULL DAY

Get started at 8:30 AM from your hotel venturing out to the Cu Chi countryside. See what life was like for the guerrilla warriors who lived and fought underground during the war. Crawl through 50 m of the 200 km tunnel system below. This morning you also pay a visit to a rice paper workshop. In the afternoon see the real HCM City through the eyes of a local. Visit the bustling Cho Lon market and a hidden Chinese pagoda, the Notre Dame Cathedral, the historic Central Post Office, and City Hall. We drop you off at your hotel around 5:30 PM

Day 8

HCMC DEPARTURE- SIEM REAP, SOUR SDEY "HELLO" **CAMBODIA**

Breakfast at hotel. Depending on your flight. Transfer to Airport. Upon arrival at Siem Reap Int's Airport, process immigration procedure (visa on arrival is available or obtain in advance via www.evisa.gov.kh), then get your luggage and walk straight to the Exit Gate where our representative is waiting. After self-introduced, you'll transfer directly around 30 minutes to the hotel in the city for check in (check in time is 2pm). Time to fresh-up and relax at hotel. Overnight in Siem Reap.

ANGKOR HIGHLIGHTS

Enjoy breakfast at hotel. Beat the crowd early morning by 7 am; visit the picturesque Ta Prohm that had nearly disappeared into the jungle and remains overgrown, an oddly haunting and exotic scene. The magnificent roots of a tree, pushing between the huge stone blocks of the temple in a sort of embrace, evoke feelings that you may remember forever. We drive to Angkor Thom that was the masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the occupation of Angkor by the Chams from 1177 to 1181, the new king decided to build an impregnable fortress at the heart of his empire. We begin to visit Bayon Temple. At the exact center of Angkor Thom, this is an eccentric expression of the creative genius and inflated ego of Cambodia's most celebrated king. We continue to visit Terrace of the Leper King. Along the Terrace of Elephants, originally used as a viewing gallery for the king to preside over parades, performances and traditional sports. At the southern end lies the Baphuon, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Uditayavarman 1 in the 11th century. We journey out to the mother of all temples, Angkor Wat. Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 10 SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

Transfer to Siem Reap airport for departure to next destination. It's time to say goodbye, we thank you for traveling with us and warmly welcome you to come again.
