Next, stop by the Batasia Loop, an engineering marvel that showcases a spiral railway track, a fascinating sight for anyone with a love of history and architecture. After breakfast, immerse yourself in the spirit of adventure at the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, a place that will ignite the explorer within. For wildlife lovers, the P.N. Zoological Park (closed on Thursdays) offers a glimpse of rare and endangered species, while the Tenzing Rock invites you to challenge yourself with a 50-foot-high climb. Visit the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed on Sundays), a testament to resilience and culture, and take in the scenic views of Darjeeling's tea gardens, where the verdant hills stretch as far as the eye can see. If you seek more excitement, the Ropeway ride promises sweeping views of the town, and a visit to the Japanese Temple will bring a sense of tranquility. In the evening, take some free time to indulge in shopping or simply relax, soaking in the charm of Darjeeling at your own pace. After a day filled with adventure, history, and beauty, return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay, ready for more explorations tomorrow.

Day 3 Mirik Excursion

After a delightful breakfast, set off for a captivating full-day excursion to Mirik Lake, situated at a serene altitude of 4,902 feet. On the way, you'll pass by the Indo-Nepal Border, where the landscape shifts and presents a unique cultural blend (please note, extra vehicle charges will apply for travel to Pasupati Market in Nepal). Mirik is renowned for its picturesque Sumendu Lake, a charming man-made body of water that forms the heart of the town. Surrounded by dense forests, lush green hills, and sprawling tea estates, the lake's beauty is simply mesmerizing. It's a perfect spot for a relaxing day in nature. You can enjoy a peaceful boating experience on the lake, with the option to fish or even have a picnic by its tranquil shores. The cool breeze and soothing sounds of nature create an atmosphere that will make you want to linger and soak in the calm beauty of this hidden gem. As the day winds down, head back to your hotel in Darjeeling, your heart full of peaceful memories from this scenic escape. After a day immersed in the beauty of Mirik, enjoy a comfortable overnight stay, ready to unwind and reflect on your experiences.
