ARRIVAL AT BANGKOK – PATTAYA ,NOONG NOOCH VILLAGE, ALCAZAR SHOW

After the show, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Pattaya.

Day 2 AT PATTAYA- CORAL ISLAND TOUR, FLOATING MARKET, TIGER PARK

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a pick-up from the lobby for the Coral Island Tour. Bask in the tropical sun as you relax on the island's pristine golden beaches, swim in the clear waters, or snorkel to explore the vibrant marine life. After a day of exciting activities, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Pattaya. Meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3 PATTAYA – BANGKOK; 165 Kms, GEMS GALLERY AND **BANGKOK CITY TOUR**

After breakfast, transfer to Bangkok and visit the Gems Gallery Pattaya, a must-see for jewelry enthusiasts, where you'll find the largest showroom of its kind in Southeast Asia. Upon arrival in Bangkok, check in to your hotel (standard check-in time is 3:00 PM). En route, enjoy a half-day city tour with a guide who will introduce you to sacred monuments, the Gems Gallery, and notable Buddha temples. Return to your hotel in Bangkok for an overnight stay. Meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4 BANGKOK – SAFARI WORLD MARINE PARK

After breakfast, head to Safari World with Marine Park, Thailand's renowned open zoo and leisure park. The park is divided into four distinct sections: Safari Park, Bird Park, Games Corner, and Macaw Island. Enjoy close encounters with dolphins, orangutans, seals, and many other exotic animals and birds, all set in a picturesque African-themed environment. Have lunch at the Safari World Park and then return to your hotel in Bangkok for an overnight stay. Meals for the day include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 5 BANGKOK

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and enjoy some free time for shopping at your own pace. Later, you will be transferred to the airport. Meals for the day include breakfast and lunch only.
