Arrival in Bangkok – Transfer to Pattaya & Visit Nong Nooch Village, Alcazar Show

Coral Island Tour, Pattaya Floating Market & Tiger Park

Day 3 Transfer to Bangkok – Gems Gallery & City Tour

Safari World & Marine Park

The park is divided into four exciting zones: Safari Park, Bird Park, Games Corner, and Macaw Island. At Safari Park, embark on a drive-through safari to get up close with dolphins, orangutans, and seals in an African-inspired setting. Explore Bird Park, home to exotic birds from across the globe, and Macaw Island, featuring colorful macaws and other species. The park also offers thrilling animal shows that are favorites among visitors. After a thrilling day at the park, enjoy lunch before returning to your hotel in Bangkok for an overnight stay. Shopping & Departure

Where the cancellation request is made on or after the second day prior to the Tour commencement date, the Company shall make no refund to the customer. In any other case, including 'No Show', the Company shall make no refund to the customer.
