ARRIVAL AT BANGKOK – PATTAYA ,NOONG NOOCH VILLAGE, ALCAZAR SHOW

In the evening, attend the famous Alcazar Show, where professional performers dazzle the audience with stunning costumes and cutting-edge stage technology. Overnight stay in Pattaya.

Day 2 AT PATTAYA- CORAL ISLAND TOUR, FLOATING MARKET, TIGER PARK

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll be picked up from the lobby and taken on a Coral Island tour. Spend the day soaking up the warm tropical sun, relaxing on the island's pristine golden beaches. You can swim, snorkel, or simply unwind under the sun. For those seeking adventure, diving into the clear waters is also an option. Later, head to the Pattaya Floating Market, where traditional thatched huts on stilts host vendors offering handicrafts, Thai street food, and souvenirs from across the country. The market is divided into four sections, each representing the unique culture and architecture of Thailand's four main regions: north, northeast, central, and south. Next, visit Tiger Park for a memorable encounter with the world's largest cat species. Enjoy a fun and safe experience as you interact with friendly tigers, take photos with them, and even have the opportunity to feed the smaller ones if they're hungry. Overnight stay in Pattaya. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)

Day 3 PATTAYA – BANGKOK; 165 Kms, GEMS GALLERY AND **BANGKOK CITY TOUR**

After breakfast, transfer to Bangkok. If you're a fan of jewelry, gemstones, or shopping, be sure to visit Gems Gallery Pattaya, the largest showroom of its kind in Southeast Asia. Upon arrival in Bangkok, check into your hotel (standard check-in time is 3:00 PM). On the way, enjoy a guided half-day city tour, which includes visits to sacred monuments, a gems gallery, and a Buddha temple. End the day with an overnight stay in Bangkok. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)

Day 4 BANGKOK – SAFARI WORLD MARINE PARK

After breakfast, embark on a tour of Safari World with Marine Park, one of Thailand's most popular open zoos and leisure parks. The park is divided into four unique zones: Safari Park, Bird Park, Games Corner, and Macaw Island. Lunch will be served at Safari World Park. Overnight stay in Bangkok. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)

Day 5 BANGKOK

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and enjoy some free time for shopping at your leisure. Later, you will be transferred to the airport. (Meals: Breakfast Only)
