Amristar Kashmir- Ex Cochin

AMRITSAR ARRIVAL

Arrive in Amritsar, a city renowned for its spiritual and cultural significance. Check in to your hotel and freshen up. Later, visit the historic Jallianwala Bagh and the magnificent Golden Temple. Overnight stay in Amritsar.

Day 2

AMRITSAR DROP & SRINAGAR ARRIVAL

After breakfast, check out and head to Amritsar Airport for your flight to Srinagar. Upon arrival in Srinagar, often hailed as the pride of Kashmir, known for its picturesque lakes and Mughal Gardens, you'll start your sightseeing with a visit to Nishat Garden, or the 'Garden of Pleasure,' built in 1633 by Mughal Emperor Asif Khan. Next, explore Shalimar Garden, or the 'Garden of Love,' established in 1619 by Mughal Emperor Jahangir for his beloved wife Noor Jehan (Mehr-un-Nissa). In the evening, enjoy a serene Shikara ride on Dal Lake. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 3 SRINAGAR - GULMARG - SRINAGAR

Gulmarg, situated at 8,700 feet (2,652 meters), is renowned as the 'Meadow of Flowers.' Discovered by a Kashmiri romantic poet in the 16th century, its lush grassy slopes covered with wildflowers inspired many. Today, Gulmarg stands as one of India's premier hill resorts. In winter, it transforms into a top skiing destination. The Gondola Cable Car (at your own expense) provides rides to the upland meadows of Kongdori and up to the Affarwat range at 14,000 feet, offering stunning views of the Himalayan peaks in summer and excellent skiing opportunities in winter. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 4 SRINAGAR - PAHALGAM - SRINAGAR

Proceed to Pahalgam, situated at 2,133 meters and often referred to as 'The Valley of Shepherds' or 'Trekker's Paradise.' Known for its stunning beauty, Pahalgam is a popular location for the Indian Film Industry and offers breathtaking views. It also serves as the gateway to the Amarnath Cave, a revered Hindu pilgrimage site. Explore Mini Switzerland, Baisaran, Dabyan, and Kashmir Valley on horseback. Overnight stay in Pahalgam.

Day 5 SRINAGAR - SONMARG - SRINAGAR

After breakfast, drive to Sonmarg, known as the 'Meadow of Gold.' Nestled in the Sindh Valley at an altitude of 2,690 meters, Sonmarg is a place of stunning beauty, surrounded by snow-capped mountains and lush with flowers. Less frequented by tourists, it offers a serene alpine retreat with its backdrop of snowy peaks and clear skies. The area is adorned with sycamore, silver birch, fir, and pine trees and serves as the last stop on the Kashmir side before the drive to Leh. It is also a base for treks to the high-altitude Himalayan lakes. After lunch at a local restaurant, capture the magnificent mountain views with your camera. You may also enjoy an optional horse ride. In the evening, return to Srinagar.

Day 6 SRINAGAR DROP & AMRITSAR ARRIVAL

After breakfast, transfer to Srinagar airport for your flight to Amritsar. Upon arrival, proceed to your hotel. Later, visit the Wagah Border to witness the renowned daily flag-lowering ceremony. Overnight stay in Amritsar.

AMRITSAR

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and transfer to Amritsar Airport for your onward journey.

- PAHALGAM: Aru, Chandanwari, Betab valley Starting rate 4500/- For ECO. Pony/Horse for Baisaran Valley 2500/- 3000/- Per Horse/Pony.

- Prepaid sim cards don't work in J & K due to security reasons, post-paid connection is must.
- In Srinagar if you are staying at the Houseboat Shikara Crossing is complimentary, do not pay for the same.
- It is not mandatory for guest to take ponies in Sonamarg/Gulmarg & Pahalgam to visit all the important tourist spots, all the major tourist at-traction point are in close proximity so you can walk it down. However if still you wish to take pony ride/sledging/rafting etc the rates the highly negotiable. Please bargain to your max.
- Sightseeing to Aru Valley/Beetab Valley/Chandanwari at Pahalgam will be by local taxi union only. Due to union outside vehicles cannot enter these places. The rate are highly negotiable if you wish to visit these places. You have to pay extra directly.
