Day 1 NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport - Darjeeling (75 Kms. / 3 Hrs.)

Welcome to the enchanting hills of Darjeeling! Upon your arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station or Bagdogra International Airport, you will be warmly greeted and transferred to this charming hill station, nestled at 6,950 feet. The scenic drive, winding through lush tea gardens, vibrant villages, and panoramic mountain views, will set the perfect tone for your adventure. As you arrive in Darjeeling, check into your hotel and unwind in the cool, crisp mountain air. The rest of the day is at leisure, offering you the perfect opportunity to explore the town at your own pace. Stroll through the bustling streets, visit local markets, or simply relax and take in the breathtaking views of snow-capped peaks and lush valleys that surround you. In the evening, immerse yourself in the serene ambiance of this quaint hill station, and let the charm of Darjeeling leave its imprint on your heart. Overnight stay at Darjeeling, where every moment is a delightful discovery of nature and culture.

Day 2 Darjeeling Full Day Sightseeing with Tiger Hill

(Please note: Access to Tiger Hill is subject to permit/token availability.) After this magical moment, return to your hotel to enjoy a hearty breakfast. The rest of the day is filled with awe-inspiring attractions as you set out at 8:30 AM to explore Darjeeling's top sights. Begin with a visit to the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, where you can learn about the legendary expeditions of Tenzing Norgay and other mountaineering icons. Then, head to the P.N. Zoological Park (closed on Thursdays), home to rare and endangered wildlife from the Himalayas. For adventure enthusiasts, a visit to Tenzing Rock will offer an exciting climbing experience. Afterward, take a ride on the Ropeway, enjoying panoramic views of the lush valleys below. Your journey continues with a visit to the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed on Sundays), where you can purchase beautiful Tibetan handicrafts and learn about the region's heritage. No trip to Darjeeling is complete without a stop at a Tea Garden. Marvel at the sight of sprawling tea estates and enjoy the calming atmosphere before heading to the tranquil Japanese Temple, where the scent of incense and the peaceful surroundings will help you unwind. The evening is free for you to relax, shop for souvenirs, or simply stroll around the town soaking in its charm. Overnight stay at Darjeeling, where every corner offers a new adventure, and the beauty of the Himalayas never leaves your sight.

Day 3 Excursion to Mirik (49 Kms. / 2½ Hrs. one-way)

Begin your day with a delicious breakfast before embarking on a scenic drive to Mirik (4,902 ft.), a charming hill station renowned for its serene ambiance and breathtaking vistas. The journey itself is a treat, as you wind through lush tea gardens, vibrant orange orchards, fragrant cardamom plantations, and towering pine forests, with the majestic Mt. Kanchenjunga gracing the backdrop. At the heart of Mirik lies the enchanting Sumendu Lake, a man-made marvel surrounded by forested hills and connected by a picturesque arching footbridge. Enjoy the tranquil beauty of the lake as you stroll along its banks or indulge in a peaceful boating experience or a delightful horse ride, both available on a direct payment basis. The serene setting of the lake, with its mirror-like reflections of the surrounding greenery, makes it a perfect spot for relaxation and photography. On your return journey to Darjeeling, make a stop at the Pasupati Market, located at the Indo-Nepal border. This vibrant market offers a wide range of goods, from unique handicrafts to fashionable clothing, perfect for those looking for a bit of retail therapy. (Please note: Additional vehicle charges apply for access to the Nepal border and market, payable directly.) As evening falls, return to your hotel in Darjeeling, where you can unwind and reminisce about the day's serene adventures. Overnight stay at Darjeeling, where nature's splendor continues to captivate your soul.

Day 4 Darjeeling - Gangtok (100 Kms. / 4 Hrs.)

Situated at an elevation of 5,500 ft., Gangtok offers a stunning blend of natural beauty, cultural richness, and modern appeal. Along the way, you'll catch glimpses of terraced fields and cascading streams, all set against the backdrop of the majestic Himalayas. This shrine is dedicated to Baba Harbhajan Singh, a legendary Indian Army soldier who is believed to guard the region. The temple holds immense spiritual significance and offers panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes, making it a unique combination of devotion and natural splendor. As the day winds down, return to Gangtok, cherishing the unforgettable sights and stories of the day. Overnight stay at Gangtok, where the allure of the Himalayas continues to captivate your heart. Note: Ensure you carry two passport-size photographs and a photocopy of valid ID proof (Passport, Driving License, or Voter ID; PAN Card and Aadhaar Card are not accepted). For children below 18 years, carry a birth certificate or school/college ID. Originals must be presented while traveling. In case of landslides or other disruptions, alternate sightseeing arrangements will be made.

Day 6 Gangtok Full Day Local Sightseeing

After a delightful breakfast, set out to explore the many treasures of Gangtok on a full-day city tour that unveils its cultural richness and natural beauty. Begin with a visit to the Tashi Viewpoint, where the panoramic vistas of the snow-clad Himalayas and Mount Kanchenjunga are bound to leave you awestruck. Then, head to Ganesh Tok and Hanuman Tok, serene temples perched on hilltops offering stunning views and a tranquil atmosphere, perfect for a moment of reflection. Next, immerse yourself in the vibrant colors of Gangtok's Flower Show, a feast for the eyes with its collection of exotic and seasonal blooms. Continue to the Cottage Industry and Handicraft Centre (closed on Sundays and specific Saturdays), where you can marvel at the intricate craftsmanship and perhaps take home a piece of Sikkim's artistry. Dive deeper into the region's cultural heritage at the Institute of Tibetology (closed on Sundays), a repository of rare Buddhist manuscripts, art, and artifacts that showcases the rich Tibetan influence in the region. Nearby, the peaceful Dro-dul Chorten stands as a symbol of spirituality, its golden spire gleaming in the sunlight. Visit the serene Gonjang Monastery, known for its spiritual ambiance and stunning architecture. Conclude the tour at the captivating Banjakhri Falls, where cascading waters amidst lush greenery offer a refreshing retreat. As the day concludes, return to your hotel with memories of Gangtok's unique charm etched in your heart. Overnight stay in Gangtok, where the hills whisper tales of nature and culture.

Day 7 Gangtok - NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport (128 Kms. / 5 Hrs.)
