Day 1 **New York**

Welcome to New York! Upon arrival at JFK Airport, your driver will meet you and transfer you to a world-class hotel in the fashionable area of Manhattan. This show features a fast-paced, high-energy lineup of specialty acts and daredevil stunts from around the world, earning it the title of "Best Las Vegas Show." The show starts at 8:30 p.m. Important: If, for any reason, you are unable to attend the show, please note that we are not liable, and no refunds will be issued. If the V show is not available, a similar show will be offered. After the show, walk back to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 8 Las Vegas (no coach)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. The day is yours to spend at leisure, or you may opt for an optional Grand Canyon Tour. If you have booked the Grand Canyon tour through us, your tour manager will drop you off at the designated pickup location. For those taking the Grand Canyon coach tours, breakfast will be packed. In the evening, meet your tour manager for dinner at an Indian restaurant. After dinner, get ready to explore the bright lights of the famous Las Vegas Strip on a coach tour. You'll enjoy unobstructed views of the glitz and glamour that make Vegas iconic. Next, visit some of the must-see landmarks, including the Fremont Street Experience, where you can marvel at the Viva Vision Light Show—a spectacular sound and light display on an immense canopy screen. This stop will dazzle you with 12 million LEDs flashing under a four-block-long canopy, with zip liners soaring overhead. The rest of the evening is free for you to explore at your own pace. Day 9 Las Vegas – Los Angeles

With a wide range of stores, including J.Crew Factory, Tommy Hilfiger, Abercrombie & Fitch Outlet, and Nike Factory Store, there's something for everyone. After shopping, proceed with a guided city tour of Los Angeles led by an experienced guide. Explore the bustling streets of LA, stroll along the iconic Walk of Fame, visit the Dolby Theatre, and take a scenic drive down Rodeo Drive. Don't miss the opportunity to capture a photo of the famous Hollywood sign from one of the best vantage points. After the tour, check into your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 10 10 Los Angeles – Fresno, CA.

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, spend the day at Universal Studios Hollywood. This sprawling amusement park offers thrilling theme rides, entertaining shows, diverse restaurants, and shops, all within one of the oldest real working movie studios still in use today. After a relaxing lunch, join a guided city tour that covers all the major highlights of San Francisco. The tour will include a visit to Twin Peaks, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the Bay Area from two prominent hills standing about 922 feet tall. Conclude your day with a ride on a historic cable car, the world's last manually operated system (subject to operation). Enjoy dinner at an Indian restaurant before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 13 San Francisco

After breakfast, check out from the hotel (check-out time is 11 a.m.). Transfers to the airport will be provided. For early flights, please arrange a cab on your own. Safe travels!
