Day 1 Arrival in Phnom Penh

Arrive in Phnom Penh, the capital city of Cambodia, where your journey begins. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by our tour guide, who will assist you with your transfer to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free for you to relax and explore at your leisure. Phnom Penh, with its mix of traditional and French colonial architecture, offers a great introduction to the country. Day 2 Exploring Phnom Penh's History and Culture

Your second day in Cambodia will take you through the capital's fascinating history. Start with a visit to the Royal Palace, the official residence of Cambodia's King, where you can admire the stunning Silver Pagoda, home to the famous Emerald Buddha statue studded with thousands of diamonds. Afterward, head to Wat Phnom, the city's most important temple, and then make your way to S-21 (Tuol Sleng) prison camp and the Killing Fields of Choeung Ek. This poignant visit will offer a deeper understanding of Cambodia's tragic history under the Khmer Rouge regime. Inclusion: Transfer, Guide, Entrance Fees, Water, Breakfast, Hotel.

Day 3 Phnom Penh to Siem Reap

After breakfast, travel from Phnom Penh to Siem Reap, where the famous Angkor temples await you. On the way, enjoy the scenic journey through rural villages, provincial towns, and vibrant Cambodian landscapes. A unique stop will be at Skun, also known as "Spider Ville," where you can sample deep-fried tarantulas—a local delicacy. Continue to Sambor Prei Kuk, a pre-Angkorian temple complex featuring hundreds of temples dating back to the Chenla Kingdom. On the way to Siem Reap, stop in Kompong Kdei to view the ancient Angkorian bridge, Spean Pratos. Inclusion: Transfer, Guide, Entrance Fees, Water, Breakfast, Hotel.

Day 4 Exploring Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat

Today, prepare for a full day of exploration at the Angkor Archaeological Park. Begin with a visit to Angkor Thom, the grand walled city, where you can admire the Bayon Temple with its iconic 54 towers, each crowned with four faces of Avalokiteshvara, the Buddha of Compassion. Continue to the Terrace of the Leper King and the Terrace of Elephants, both of which offer fascinating historical insights. Visit Baphuon, one of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, known for its massive structure and intricate carvings. After lunch, head to Ta Prohm, famously featured in Tomb Raider, and then end your day at Angkor Wat, the largest religious monument in the world, where you can soak in its tranquility and splendor. Inclusion: Transfer, Guide, Entrance Fees, Water, Breakfast, Hotel.

Day 5 Tonle Sap Lake and Departure

On your final day, take a boat trip to Tonle Sap Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Southeast Asia. Visit Kompong Pluk, a floating village where you will see houses built on stilts, floating markets, and impressive flooded forests that provide a glimpse of life on the water. After returning to Siem Reap, visit Artisans d'Angkor, a social enterprise dedicated to preserving Cambodian traditional arts. Take a tour of the workshops where artisans create silk fabrics, stone carvings, lacquerware, and more. In the evening, you will be transferred to Siem Reap airport for your departure. Inclusion: Transfer, Guide, Entrance Fees, Water, Breakfast.
