For those interested in history, Varanasi's silk market and bustling streets offer a taste of local life, while its street food presents an unforgettable culinary adventure.
 A short trip from Varanasi leads to Sarnath, where Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon after enlightenment. It is home to ancient stupas, monasteries, and the famous Sarnath Museum. The peaceful atmosphere here complements the spiritual energy of the nearby temples and ruins.
 Whether seeking spiritual enlightenment or a cultural journey, Varanasi promises an experience that connects you with the timeless essence of India.

Day 1

Arrivals at Varanasi – Sightseeing

Upon your arrival at Varanasi Airport or Railway Station, our representatives will warmly greet you. You will then be transferred to your pre-booked hotel for check-in and some rest. In the evening, experience the breathtaking Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat. This sacred ceremony, performed daily, involves chanting hymns and offering lamps to praise the river goddess, Ganga. You can witness this mesmerizing ritual from the ghat or enjoy a boat ride on the river (optional). Afterward, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Varanasi.

Day 2

Varanasi – Temple & Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, visit some of the most revered temples of Varanasi, including the Old Kashi Vishwanath Temple, Annapurna Temple, Vishalakshi Temple, and Kal Bhairav Temple. Continue your temple tour with visits to Ramnagar Fort, New Kashi Vishwanath Temple (BHU) also known as Birla Temple, Sankat Mochan Temple, Durga Temple, and Tulsi Manas Mandir. After exploring the temples, take some time to shop for famous Varanasi silk at the local markets. End the day by indulging in some of Varanasi's delicious street food. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3

Varanasi – Sarnath Excursion

After breakfast, visit Markande Mahadev Mandir and enjoy a boat ride to witness the confluence of the Gomati and Ganges rivers. Next, explore the Swarved Maha Mandir meditation center. Continue with a visit to Sarnath, a key Buddhist site where Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon after attaining enlightenment. In Sarnath, visit the Mulagandhakuti Vihara, Sarnath Museum, Chaukhandi Stupa, Dhamekh Stupa, Dharmarajika Stupa, and the ancient monastery. Return to your hotel in Varanasi for the evening.

Day 4

Varanasi -Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to Varanasi Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey. Take with you beautiful memories of this spiritual journey to one of India's most sacred and historic cities.
