Varanasi Prayagraj Ayodhya

> Start your spiritual journey in Varanasi, also known as Kashi, one of the oldest cities in the world. A visit to Varanasi is a truly transformative experience, as the city is teeming with temples, ghats, and sacred rituals. The Kashi Vishwanath Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, stands as a testament to the city's divine legacy. Witness the mesmerizing Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat, where the sacred Ganges River becomes the focal point of devotion every evening. As you explore the bustling streets, you'll discover ancient temples and vibrant markets, offering everything from religious artifacts to intricate silk sarees.
 Next, journey to Prayagraj, where the confluence of the holy rivers Ganges, Yamuna, and the mystical Sarasvati creates the sacred Triveni Sangam. Known for its significance in Hindu mythology, this city is a hub for spiritual practices. Visit iconic landmarks like the Anand Bhawan, once the home of India's first Prime Minister, and the revered Hanuman Temple. The city is also known for its Shakti Peeths, including the Alopi Devi Temple, drawing countless pilgrims each year.
 Your journey culminates in Ayodhya, the birthplace of Lord Rama and one of the most significant pilgrimage sites in India. Here, you'll visit landmarks steeped in history, such as the Kanak Bhawan and the Ram Mandir. The city's connection to the epic Ramayana is undeniable, and a visit to Guptar Ghat, where Lord Rama is believed to have taken Jal Samadhi, brings you closer to India's ancient traditions. Experience the spiritual ambiance of Bharat Khud and Makhuda Dham, adding layers of significance to your journey through this sacred land.

Day 1 Arrivals at Varanasi – Sightseeing

Upon your arrival at Varanasi Airport or Railway Station, our representatives will meet and greet you. You will then be transferred to your pre-booked hotel for check-in. After a refreshment break, in the evening, experience the magnificent Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat. This nightly ritual involves offering lamps to the sacred river Ganges while chanting hymns. You can witness the aarti either from the ghat or enjoy a boat ride on the river (optional, direct payment). Afterward, return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Varanasi.

Day 2 Varanasi Sightseeing

Begin your day early at 5 AM with a visit to the Old Kashi Vishwanath Temple, Annapurna Temple, and Vishalakshi Temple, all located within the same complex. Continue your temple exploration with a visit to Kal Bhairav Temple. Afterward, return to your hotel for breakfast. Later, take an excursion to Sarnath, a key Buddhist site where Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon. In Sarnath, visit the Mulagandhakuti Vihara, Sarnath Museum, Chaukhandi Stupa, Dhamekh Stupa, Dharmarajika Stupa, and the famous Sarang Nath Temple. In the evening, visit Birla Mandir (New Kashi Vishwanath Temple), Sankat Mochan Mandir, Durga Temple, Tulsi Manas Mandir, and Bharat Mata Mandir. Return to the hotel for a peaceful overnight stay.

Day 3 Varanasi – Prayagraj

After breakfast, drive to Prayagraj. Upon arrival, visit the Holy Triveni Sangam, where the Ganges, Yamuna, and mythical Saraswati rivers meet. Explore Hanuman Temple, Anand Bhawan, Alopi Devi Temple (Shakti Peeth), Vat Vraksh Temple, and Shri Maa Lalita Devi Temple (Shakti Peeth). After sightseeing, drive back to Varanasi, check in to the hotel, and enjoy a peaceful overnight stay.

Day 4 Prayagraj - Ayodhya

After breakfast, drive to Ayodhya. Upon arrival, visit Kanak Bhawan, Hanuman Garhi, Ram Mandir, and Dasrath Mahal. In the evening, experience the light show at Surajkund at 8 PM. After the show, return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Ayodhya.

Day 5 Ayodhya Sightseeing

After breakfast, visit the sacred Guptar Ghat, where Lord Rama is believed to have performed Jal Samadhi. Continue to Bharat Khud, where King Bharat resided during Lord Rama's exile. Visit Makhuda Dham, where King Dashrath performed a Yajna to seek the blessing of a son. Finish your day with a visit to Swami Narayan Mandir, then return to the hotel for a peaceful overnight stay.

Ayodhya Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel, and you will be dropped at Ayodhya Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey. Leave with memories of this spiritually fulfilling journey through the heart of India's ancient religious landscape.
