Your journey continues in Bentota, where water sports and boat rides along the Madhu River await. The final stop in Colombo offers a mix of city charm, from shopping to vibrant nightlife. With a rich blend of nature, history, and culture, Sri Lanka is a destination that promises to captivate and rejuvenate every traveler.

Day 1 Arrival – Kandy Exploration

Upon arrival in Sri Lanka, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to Kandy. En route, visit the Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage, where you can observe the elephants being bathed and fed. In the evening, enjoy a Cultural Show that highlights traditional Sri Lankan music and dance. Afterward, visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, an important Buddhist site that houses the Buddha's tooth. Explore the Peradeniya Botanical Garden, known for its impressive collection of tropical flora, and visit a Gem Shop to learn about Sri Lanka's gem industry. Overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 2 Kandy to Nuwara Eliya – Scenic Views and Tea Gardens

After breakfast, journey from Kandy to Nuwara Eliya. On the way, stop at Ramboda Hanuman Temple and visit a Tea Factory, where you can learn about Sri Lanka's famous tea production. Explore the Gayathri Peedam and the Seetha Amman Temple, which are significant for their cultural and religious value. Continue your tour with a visit to the Tea Gardens that offer scenic views of the hills and valleys. In the afternoon, enjoy a visit to Gregory Lake, where you can take a boat ride, and explore Victoria Park for a relaxed stroll. Overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 3 Nuwara Eliya to Bentota – Adventure and Nature

This morning, travel from Nuwara Eliya to Bentota. You can choose between an optional train ride through the picturesque hill country or engage in rafting at Kitulgala, an adventure for thrill-seekers. Upon arrival in Bentota, visit the Turtle Farm, which focuses on turtle conservation. Afterward, take a boat ride in the Madhu River, where you can enjoy the lush surroundings and wildlife. Spend the rest of the day enjoying water sports at Bentota's beautiful beaches. Overnight stay in Bentota.

Day 4 Bentota to Colombo – City Tour and Shopping

In the morning, head towards Colombo, the capital city. Enjoy a City Tour of Colombo, visiting important landmarks such as Fort, Cinnamon Gardens, and the Independence Square. Take a stroll through Pettah Market for local shopping or visit the BMICH (Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall). You can also opt for a one-way drop to a Casino for some entertainment. Enjoy some leisure time in Colombo before returning to the hotel. Overnight stay in Colombo.

Day 5 Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to the airport for your departure flight, marking the end of your Sri Lankan journey.
