Delhi Railway Station / Airport –Hotel

Marvel at its red sandstone palaces, the spiritual serenity of Salim Chishti's Dargah, and the towering Buland Darwaza, the world's largest gateway, standing as a symbol of Akbar's triumph. Arrive in Jaipur, a city brimming with royal heritage and vibrant culture. Check into your hotel and unwind, as tomorrow promises an exciting adventure through Rajasthan's regal wonders. Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 4 Jaipur Local Sightseeing
