The Gondola Cable Car (at own cost) offers rides to the upland meadows of Kongdori and beyond to the top of Affarwat range to a height of 14000 ft for viewing the Himalayan Peaks in summer and for downhill skiing in winter Overnight stay in Srinagar

SRINAGAR-PAHALGAM
