Overview **Glorious Kashmir**

Some major tourist attractions in Jammu and Kashmir are Srinagar, the Mughal Gardens, Gulmarg, Pahalgam, Patnitop, Bhaderwah and Jammu. Every year, thousands of Hindu pilgrims visit holy shrines of Vaishno Devi and Amarnath which has had significant impact on the state's economy. Jammu and Kashmir is also famous for its scenic beauty, flower gardens, apple farms and more. It attracts tourists for its unique handicrafts and the world-famous Kashmiri Shawls.

Day 1 **SRINAGAR ARRIVAL**

Srinagar, pride of the beautiful valley of Kashmir famous for its lakes dotted with Shikaras and the Mughal Gardens. Transfer to Hotel/ Houseboat. day at leisure, Shikara ride to Nehru Park in the evening (at your own Cost). Overnight hotel stay in Srinagar.

Day 2 **SRINAGAR – GULMARG - SRINAGAR**

Gulmarg (8700 ft i.e. 2652 mts), known as 'Meadow of flowers. Discovered by the Kashmiri romantic poet in the 16th century who was inspired with its grassy slopes covered with wild flowers. It is one of the India's premier Hill resorts. Gulmarg today is not merely a mountain resort of exceptional beauty – It also turns into India's premier Ski resort in winter. The Gondola Cable Car (at own cost) offers rides to the upland meadows of Kongdori and beyond to the top of Affarwat range to a height of 14000 ft for viewing the Himalayan Peaks in summer and for downhill skiing in winter. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 3 **SRINAGAR - PAHALGAM**

Morning after breakfast drive to Pahalgam is the most famous place for Indian Film Industry. Enroute you can see saffron fields, Awantipura Ruins. On arrival check in to hotel and short trek to Famous Baisaran Valley also known as Mini Switzerland. Evening drive back to hotel & Overnight stay at hotel in Pahalgam.

Day 4 **PAHALGAM - SRINAGAR LOCAL SIGHTSEEING**

Morning after breakfast drive to Srinagar and on arrival proceed to famous Nishat Garden known as 'Garden of pleasure' built in 16thP century (1633) by Mughal Emperor Asif Khan. Then visiting Shalimar Garden known as 'Garden of love' built in 16thP century (1619) by Mughal Emperor Jahangir for his beloved wife Noor Jehan or (Mehr-un-Nissa). Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 5 **SRINAGAR AIRPORT**

Morning after breakfast timely transfer to Srinagar airport to board the flight for your respective destination.

- PAYMENT POLICY : At the time of booking 60% of the total cost should be paid which is non-refundable 30 days before the travel date- Balance amount should be paid
- JURISDICTION: Indian law will govern the terms & conditions of this package. Any disputes between customer and the company shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Kochi
- No rooms on Hold. Confirmation will be subject to availability at the time of confirmation
- Tour itinerary may be shuffled due to the inclement weather conditions and changes in Flight/ Ferry operations
- All the passengers should carry the valid ID during the travel
- Peak Season / Weekend Surcharges may be applicable at the time of confirmation. This will be intimated at the time of booking. However we will not be able to get this information prior
