Then visit the Church of Our Lady of the Rosary- a prime example of Manueline architecture with intricate carvings and paintings. These historic sites offer a glimpse into Goa's rich cultural heritage and attract visitors worldwide. After this, also visit Panjim, the former capital of Old Goa. Panjim is the current capital of Goa. It's a charming city that combines Indian and Portuguese cultures and architecture. Panjim is known for its colourful buildings, stunning riverside promenade, and bustling markets. In the late afternoon, take a leisurely walk to the market and shop for traditional spices and cashews at the local bazaar. Evening you will be transferred to Goa airport/railway station to board a flight/train for your onward journey.
